USGA will govern play except where local rules supersede

Local Rules

Desert Rule will be in effect

If a player's ball is lost in the desert, he will be allowed to drop his/her golf ball, with a penalty of (1) stroke on turf closest to the last point where it crossed into the desert.

Players may gently ground their club, not improving their lie, in all sand areas without penalty.

Transition Area Footprint Rule

If a player's ball comes to rest in a footprint in any of the "Transition Bunkers" the player will be allowed to pick up and place his/her golf ball outside the footprint or divot without penalty.

LA BATALLA TEAM CHAMPIONS

The teams scoring the lowest NET 36-hole total within their flight will advance to the Championship Shoot-Out.

The team successfully prevailing in the Championship Shoot-Out will be the "2024 La Batalla Champions"

FORMAT & SCORING

Two-Person Team Net Best Ball, with 100% of each player's course handicap. Players will play their own ball and record the best net score per hole.

Teams will play 36-Holes over two days. 18-Holes continuous each day.

Flights will be made up of 8 teams.

- + Men will play the La Batalla Tees
- + Ladies will play the Palm Tees.

All teams will report to Lucha Libre for scoring and lunch each day.
